- **4.1.1 NextGEN Field Trip to Ottawa April 24, 2023:** The e-vote on April 14, 2023, was for the LJA Governing Board to approve a request for the NextGEN Assembly of Leaders field trip to Ottawa on April 24, 2023. Students will meet at LJA at 6:15 am, arrive at Parliament Hill at 8:00 am, 9:00 am 4:00 pm NextGEN Assembly, and return to LJA at 7:00 pm. The NextGEN Assembly of leaders will take place at Parliament Hill in partnership with the Senate of Canada. Politicians from the federal, provincial and municipal governments will work with small groups of student leaders. Each politician will present a dossier that they are currently working on with notes and committee meeting notes to identify the problem and dialogue before the governments. By the end of the day, student leaders will present their ideas and possible solutions to their politicians.
