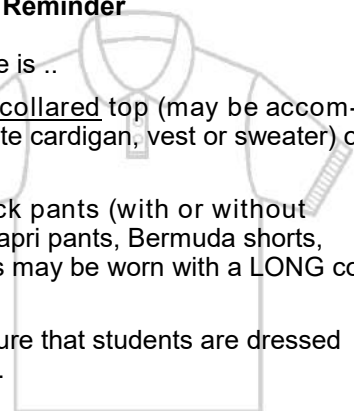
Dress Code Reminder
