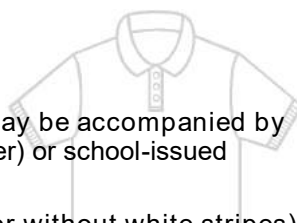
We thank them for giving us some much needed laughter!

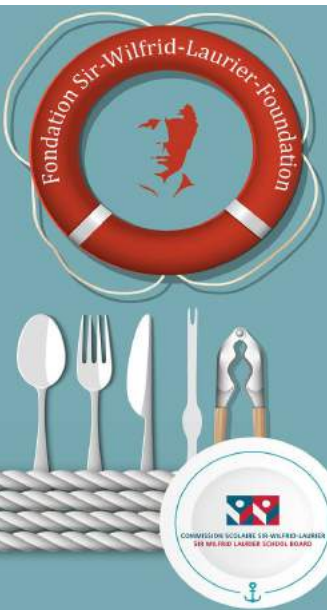
