To make the adjustment easier for them, the STL team has some helpful documents and tips to share. - As of August 1, you can go to a ticket office, <u>appointment highly recommended</u>, having the card made. Book an appointment at <u>www.stlaval.ca/rendezvous-opus</u>
- Expect to pay \$15 to have the card issued.
